30.5. – Monday (POLITICAL PROPAGANDA)

- Propaganda, dissemination of information facts, arguments, rumours, half-truths, or lies to influence public opinion.
- Propaganda is also systematic effort to manipulate other people's beliefs, attitudes, or actions by: means of symbols (words, gestures, monuments, music, clothing etc...).



30.5. – Monday

- Populist parties and social movements are often led by charismatic or dominant figures who present themselves as the "voice of the people".
- Donald Trump, Boris Johnson, Matteo Salvini, AfD Political Party, Viktor Orban and his Party Fidesz,
- anti-democracy, nationalism, racism, against immigrants, They believe in: authority, hierarchy, order, duty, tradition, reaction and nationalism.

31.5. – Tuesday (I SAW HER THAT NIGHT)

- Verbal communication is the use of words to convey a message. Some forms of verbal communication are written and oral communication. Examples of Written Communication: Letters.
- Nonverbal communication refers to the ways in which beings convey information about their emotions, needs, intentions, attitudes, and thoughts without the use of verbal language (body language, face expression,...)
- Objective: (of a person or their judgement) not influenced by personal feelings or opinions in considering and representing facts.
- Subjective: based on or influenced by personal feelings, tastes, or opinions
- Moral dilemma: a situation in which a difficult choice has to be made between two courses of action, either of which entails transgressing a moral principle.

- Motif: a recurring structure, contrast, literary device or a figure that has a symbolic significance; and contributes toward the development of a theme.
- Symbol: is an object, action or event that represents something, or creates a range of associations, beyond itself.
- Theme: it's a central idea that it conveys either directly or implicitly.




